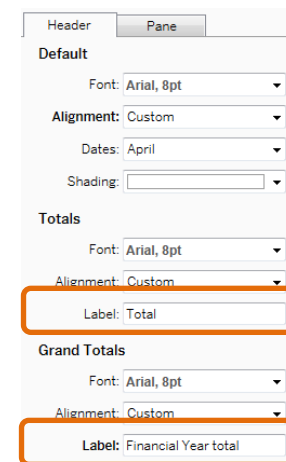
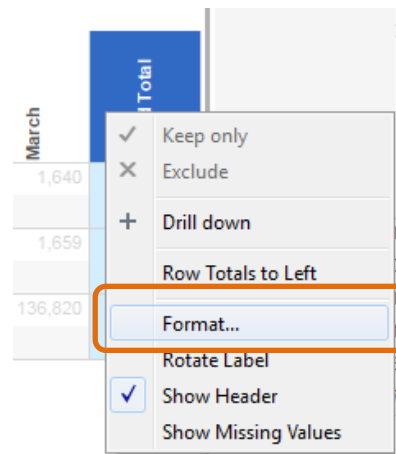

Within the formatting options displayed in the 'Side Bar' edit the Label option for the Grand Totals (you can also edit the label for Totals if you have them in your visualisation).
